For Eddi's hope was not in vain.

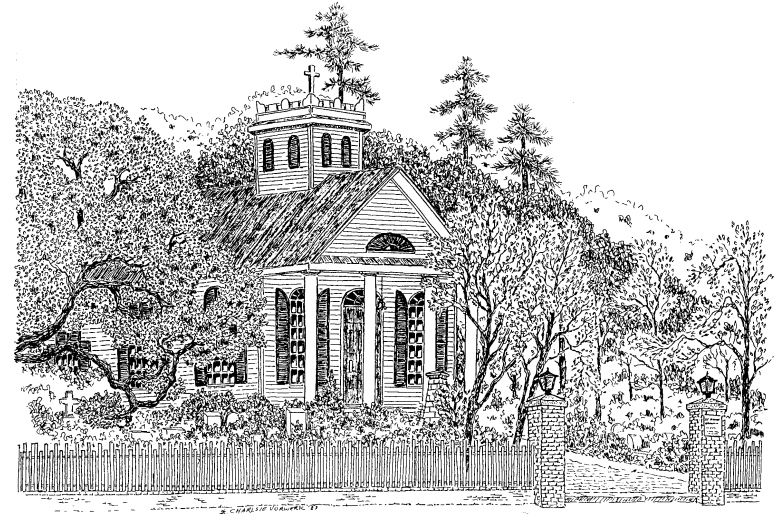
